Responsibilities of the Press Brake Operator:

- Set up and operate press brake machine

- Inspects or measure parts using ruler, gauges, squares, and other measuring tools for quality purposes.
- Load and unload materials from storage racks using a forklift.
- Must be present on the job to perform assigned duties and be able to work overtime as needed.
- Maintain a safe environment and have good housekeeping skills while working.
- Follow safety procedures including the proper use of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE).

Qualifications:

- Previous experience as Press Brake operator or other metal forming equipment is preferred.
- Experience is preferred but will train the right candidate.
- Basic blueprint experience
- Strong mechanical aptitude and basic computer skills
- Basic math skills (add, subtract, multiply, and divide whole numbers in addition to understanding fractions and decimals)
- Self-starter with a strong attention to detail and basic written and verbal communication skills.

Physical Requirements:

- While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to lift, push, pull or move up to 50 pounds.
- Be able to bend, stoop, and reach. Employee will go extended periods of time standing and performing repetitive tasks.
- The employee will also be required to stand; walk; use hand dexterity; reach with hands and arms; climb or balance, talk and hear.
